**Extreme weather trial policy**  
*Updated 1 December 2016*



**Wednesday afternoon trial sessions**

- (a) If, at 8am on the day bookings open for the affected trial session, the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) is predicting a temperature of 35 degrees or above (at the Moorabbin station) for the date of the trial session, the trial session may be moved to a 7am start and conclude no later than 11am
- (b) If, at 8am on the day bookings open for the affected trial session, the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) is predicting a temperature of 38 degrees or above (at the Moorabbin station) for the date of the trial session, the trial session may be cancelled
- (c) If during the trial session the temperature reaches 38 degrees or above according to the on course weather station, the trial session will be abandoned
- (d) The Club will always have ultimate discretion as to the cancelation or alteration of the trial session in the case of extreme heat prior to or on the day.

**Saturday morning trial sessions**

- (a) If, at 8am on the day bookings open for the affected trial session, the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) is predicting a temperature of 35 degrees or above (at the Moorabbin station) for the date of the trial session, the trial session shall conclude no later than 11am
- (b) If, at 8am on the day bookings open for the affected trial session, the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) is predicting a temperature of 38 degrees or above (at the Moorabbin station) for the date of the trial session, the trial session may be cancelled
- (c) If during the trial session the temperature reaches 38 degrees or above according to the on course weather station, the trial session will be abandoned
- (d) The Club will always have ultimate discretion as to the cancelation or alteration of the trial session in the case of extreme heat prior to or on the day.

**Post race meeting trial sessions**

Trials after race meetings will be conducted in accordance with the *GRV Hot Weather Policy*
